Use of Microcement cleaner

Usage

Add a small amount of cleaning agent to a bucket of lukewarm water. Never add more than one capful per bucket. With a full bucket, you can clean a large surface using Microcement cleaner.

Surface preparation

Ensure proper surface preparation. The surface must be dry and free of dust, oil, and grease. The temperature of the surface during application should be at least 15°C.

Storage

Store Microcement cleaner in a cool and dry place. Avoid exposure to frost and fluctuating temperatures to prevent clumping. The unopened cleaning agent is shelf-stable for 12 months. Keep out of reach of children.

Tips

- Did your floor take a beating after a great party? We get it! Before using Microcement cleaner, removing dust and dirt from the floor is essential. This can be done quickly with a Swiffer or vacuum cleaner. For filthy floors, it's best to first mop with lukewarm water. The second round can be done using Microcement cleaner, leaving your floor sparkling like never before!
- No worries if wine or food spills on your Microcement surface. Life at home is all about enjoyment! However, try to clean up spills as quickly as possible to prevent them from affecting the Microcement coating. Avoiding corrosive products such as rust removers, citrus-based cleaners, or aggressive cleaning agents like anti-limescale products is also essential.
